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Progress Not Perfection

When we began life as an infant, we lay there, unable to do anything except let others help us. Gradually, as the nourishment given by others gives us strength, we were able to begin rolling over. As time passed we were able to creep along, then to crawl. Eventually came the day when we are strong enough to stand, wobbly holding on to a chair, or a low table, or hand. When our legs gave out, or we let go, we plopped back down on the floor, later to get back up again. Later, as our legs gained more strength, we took tentative steps, holding on for balance and support to the strong hands of others, listening to their encouragement and praise. Then came the Day! We took a step on our own... and promptly fell. But we got up and took a step again ...and fell. This process went on for some time before we were able to, shakily, walk from point A to point b. As our legs became stronger and our balance became more sure, we were able to walk a little further, then a little further, until one day we were running, strong and sure, without thinking about what we were doing. It came naturally.

Our recovery process takes the same progression. We come into program as an infant, unable to do anything yet, except to have others help us. Little by little we gain the strength, through the nourishment of our sponsors, meetings, the steps, and our Higher Power. There will be faltering steps, followed by slips and falls occasionally, but, like a small child, if we get up and try again, we continue to gain strength we need to "stay the longer" until one day we are able to walk and run easily. When we, then, reach out to help another "infant" we are reminded of our own struggle and it keeps us humbly mindful of how easy it is to lose our balance. We know that while we can run and walk with ease, all it takes is a lose stone or toy underfoot to cause us to lose our balance and fall. Therefore it is important we watch, constantly, where we step so we don't take unnecessary falls. Being diligent in our own program helps prevent the "accidents" that befall those who are heedless of their surroundings. Only by using what we have learned, and taking each moment I it's turn, can we continue our recovery process, realizing we are to seek progress, not perfection.

This does *not* include permission to reprint photographs on the OA website.
