A Member Shares

"What it was like, what happened, what it is like now.

I was born a compulsive overeater into a family of compulsive eaters, alcoholics, gamblers, and emotion avoiders. My early years were bathed in so much distortion that my relationship with food morphed into what I thought was friendship, love, comfort, kindness, and stress relief. I turned to food for human needs. Food never disappointed me with rejection or argument. It is inanimate and had no repercussions, I thought.

Then food turned the corner. I was physically bigger than others. I was set aside by others. Little did I know that it was food and eating that set me aside. Not the weight, not that I was "unique." My choice was food at all costs. Food as a friend cut me off from all things human. I was lonely and resentful because I did not build human skills to give to or receive from others. I remained distorted for 3 decades of my life.

I found recovery when all my score cards read zero. Rock bottom had to be hit for me to look for something better. That was the inevitable and necessary place I needed to go. My whole life changed when I put the food down and looked to the people I found in Overeaters Anonymous. Especially my first sponsor. I was feral. A young person without human skills. She loved me enough to teach me how to abstain, how to clean my house, how to work the steps, who to trust, who to pass by. She taught me these things even when I was belligerent. That is love.

Now, I have been in OA longer than the 3 decades during which I was so distorted. I have learned how to cope with life without excess food. I can love, therefore, I have love in my life. I can learn and I can guide others. I can limit myself to live within my own budget. My emotional budget, my financial budget, and my service budget are all largely intact. By staying in the basics of OA, working the steps, traditions, and concepts of service, using all the tools, I have a rich adult life. A life full of personal triumphs and blunders. I love myself enough to not take the first compulsive bite, one day at a time. I am ever grateful for this simple way of living."
